

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




- (12x12xm) with a diagonal in the center to avoid buckling. The joints between the different slats will be made with wooden blocks so that they are well attached. The squares will be placed in the room every
- Small square made up of wooden slats with a rectangular section (12x6cm) 52.2cm high and 34.8cm wide. Union made by nails.
- 2cm thick wooden plank that is placed on top of the small squares to serve as a seat.
- This method allows to make seats for the public without perforating the floor of the room or its walls.
